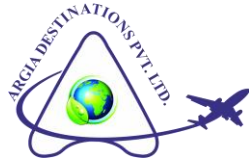

Breakfast at the hotel

Reach Vatican on your own and meet the guide there. In a small group you will visit Vatican museum, St. Peters Basilica and Sistine chapel.

At the Sistine Chapel, take some time to pick out the rich details on the walls and ceilings – from Michelangelo's boneless self-portrait to the shields representing violent bible stories.
