Tour itinerary:

HANOI - HALONG BAY - DANANG - SIEM REAP

9 days 8 nights

DAY 1: HANOI ARRIVAL - HALF DAY CITY TOUR

Upon Hanoi arrival, a warmest welcome at airport and then travelers will be transferred to hotel for check in & relax

Afternoon, visit **Ba Dinh Square** with **Hochiminh Mausoleum** (closed on every Monday, Friday), **One Pillar Pagoda** and **Hochiminh's House of Stilt**

Then visit **Temple of Literature** (the 1st National University of Vietnam), **Sword Lake** with **Ngoc Son Temple** and **The Huc Bridge**

Continue to visit & shopping at **Old Quarter** (36 ancient wards & streets) and **Dong Xuan Market**

Overnight in Hanoi

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DAY 2: HANOI - NINH BINH - HANOI (B, L)

Breakfast at hotel

Drive ahead to **Ninh Binh** - known as Ha Long Bay on Land (100km ~ 2-hour drive)

Upon arrival, visit **Hoa Lu**, a vestige of Vietnam's former capital in the 10th century. Visit temples of two dynasties **Dinh** and **Le** with unique architecture in the old time

Lunch at local restaurant

Take sampan trip along the stream to visit to **Trang An** - The Tourism Complex in the northern province of Ninh Binh was officially included in the world heritage list on June 23 by the UNESCO's World Heritage Committee. The eco tourist attraction located in the East of Ninh Binh, with area of 2000 ha, It includes 47 historical vestiges with many mysterious things, with limestone mountains, valleys and underground river systems. Take boat trip to visit cave complex: **Sang Cave, Toi Cave, Ba Giot Cave** and **Nau Ruou**

Drive back to Ha Noi

Overnight in Ha Noi

DAY 3: HANOI - HA LONG BAY (OVERNIGHT CRUISE) (B, L, D)

Breakfast at hotel

Depart for the 4-hour drive to **Halong Bay**, journey there through the rich farmlands of the Red River Delta, observe everyday life of Vietnamese villagers as they work the rice fields

Check-in on board a traditional junk

A welcome drink is served on arrival before enjoying lunch on board with fresh seafood. A fantastic cruise in Halong Bay - an UNESCO World Heritage Site, passing through so many amazing islet such as Dinh Huong Island, Ga Choi Island, Sail Island....

Enjoy some visits and/or activities (*depending on each boat's itinerary*) or just spend some time relaxing on board

Towards the end of the day the boat sets anchor for the night among the karst formations

Dinner with fresh seafood

Squid fishing or relax and chatting with your friends & family

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Overnight on board

Remarks:

+ In the occasion of bad weather conditions, e.g. high winds, monsoons, thunderstorms, cyclones, storms, etc., the management board has the authority to cancel all cruises to guarantee the safety of tourists. Should this happen, accommodation will be at Ha Long City Hotel instead

DAY 4: HA LONG BAY - NOI BAI AIRPORT - DA NANG ARRIVAL (B, BRUNCH)

Light breakfast with tea, coffee, fruit and cake are served

Enjoy your fresh morning in the middle of the bay, the sun rises on Halong in the morning with Tai Chi exercise on sundeck

The wholesome brunch is served while the vessels cruises slowly through the magnificent rock formations and back towards port

Enjoy the tranquil scenery as the boat meanders its way through the bay on the way back to Ha Long city, etc...

Disembarkation & drive back to *Noi Bai Airport* for flight to *Da Nang*. Upon arrival, check in hotel and take relaxation.

DAY 5: SIGHTSEEING IN HOI AN - DA NANG (B)

Breakfast at hotel

In the morning, proceed to *Hoi An Ancient Town*. Upon arrival, board on boat along *Thu Bon River* and stopover to visit *Thanh Ha Ceramic Village*. Try to have a hands-on experience at the potter's wheel.

Afternoon, stroll around the charming old town and visit *ancient houses, local markets, traditional handicraft workshops, Chinese community's assembly halls* and *Japanese Bridge Pagoda*

Transfer back to hotel in Da Nang for check in and relaxation

DAY 6: DA NANG - SIEM REAP ARRIVAL - TONLE SAP LAKE CRUISE (B)

Breakfast at hotel

Check out and transfer to the airport for flight to **Siem Reap**. Upon arrival, you are welcome at airport with warmest atmosphere. Transfer to hotel for check in and relaxing

Afternoon, board on boat in **Tonle Sap Lake**. Enjoy a brief cruise past floating villages complete with schools, restaurants, and hospitals.

Dinner at Indian restaurant

DAY 7: SIEM REAP TOUR (B)

Breakfast at hotel

This morning, visit the monumental magnificence of **Angkor Thom** - last capital of the Khmers, with its **Terrace of Elephants**, **Terrace of the Leper King** and the stunning **Bayon Temple**. This 12th century masterpiece lies at the very centre of Angkor Thom and is an archaeological wonder of symmetry and grandeur. Visit **Ta Prohm**, one of the area's most beautiful temples. Ta Prohm has been relatively untouched since it was discovered and retains much of its mystery

Afternoon, visit **Angkor Wat**, the largest temple in the world, with a volume of stone equaling that of the Cheops pyramid in Egypt. It is unlike all the other Khmer temples in that it faces west, and is inspired by 12th Century Hinduism. Its symmetrical towers are stylized on the modern Cambodian flag. Conceived by Suryavarman II, Angkor Wat took an estimated 30 years to build. It is generally believed to have been a funeral temple for the king. It has been occupied continuously by Buddhist monks and is well preserved. Intricate bas-reliefs surround Angkor Wat on four sides. Each tells a story. The most celebrated of these is the Churning of the Ocean of Milk, which is located on the east wing. In it the Naga serpent, is twisted by demons and gods to spurt out the elixir of life. Enjoy sunset at **Phnom Bakheng Hill**

Buffet dinner and enjoy **Apsara Dance Show** at local restaurant
